



Born Again-'Into the Spirit Realm'

John 3:7 “Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.”

Most likely, the most quoted verse in the Bible... And it is also the most misunderstood the way christianity teaches it. For most people are taught to think “born again” is a religious phrase.

YAHSHUA meant something far bigger: a rebirth into another realm.

What “Born Again” is NOT

not church membership,
not saying a prayer of ‘repentance’
not a spiritual awakening,
it is not “accepting Jesus”.
In fact, it is not religion at all.

Then what is it? Let’s do this.

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The verses in their entirety in regards to this subject are as thus:

- John 3:3 Yahshua answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of Yahweh.
- 3:4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?
- 3:5 Yahshua answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of Yahweh.
- 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 3:8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Examining these six verses will shed a bright light on what had confused Nicodemus of long ago... and our clergy of today.

Verse 3 states, '...cannot see the kingdom...' This is what is not understood. Heaven is not 'out somewhere in the cosmos.' It is right here, all around us, but in a different dimension. Humans cannot see it, that is, visualize it because the human existence is of the physical realm.

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Not of the spirit realm. There may even be an angel standing right next to you as you are reading this, but you cannot see it. This relates to what John the Baptist stated:

Matthew 3:1 In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,

3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

He did not mean that the kingdom had arrived with the arrival of the MESSIAH. Heaven is here. And it always has been. So here we start out with a short study of 'Relative Dimensions of Space and Time.' First the dimensions of length, width and height. Get a sheet of paper. Notebook or copy paper will do just fine. If not then use your water bill. Fold the paper, top to bottom, in half. Then side to side in half. Where all the folds come together, tear off the point at a half inch or so. Now open the paper up. You now have a piece of paper with a hole in the middle. This piece of paper is the two dimensional world in which you live. You have left and right, width. And you have forward and backwards, length. But you have no up or down, height. You have no understanding or even a concept of what height could be. Now place finger in the hole. Living in this two dimensional world, the finger would seem to appear out of nowhere. This is how angels make their appearances to us in our three dimensional world. They exist in a realm that we mere humans have little or no understanding of, the spirit realm. Yet they are all around us.

Now we turn to what Paul wrote to the Corinthians.

- 1 Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of Yahweh; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

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This verse calls into question the transporting of Elijah directly into heaven as found in 2 Kings.

2 Kings 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

This verse is obviously contradictory of the verse in 1 Corinthians. To shed some light on this dichotomy, the MESSIAH redresses the issue.

John 3:13 And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.

3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:

The MESSIAH, YAHSHUA, was speaking of his upcoming sacrifice when HE would be the first to ascend. Until that happened, no one had risen... Including Elijah. It's now time to take a closer look at the events surrounding Elijah's supposedly ascension.

2 Kings 2:11 'And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into **heaven.**'

Here, we are told that Elijah was taken into heaven. Indeed, the scriptures state this. But there is a problem with this statement. How is it possible for King Jehoram received a letter from Elijah six years after he was taken?

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Here in 2 Chronicles it states in verse 21:5 that King Jehoram was thirty-two years old when he his reign started, which lasted for eight years.

2 Chronicles 21:1 'Now Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.'

21:2 'And he had brethren the sons of Jehoshaphat, Azariah, and Jehiel, and Zechariah, and Azariah, and Michael, and Shephatiah: all these were the sons of Jehoshaphat king of Israel.'

21:3 'And their father gave them great gifts of silver, and of gold, and of precious things, with fenced cities in Judah: but the kingdom gave he to Jehoram; because he was the firstborn.'

21:4 'Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself, and slew all his brethren with the sword, and divers also of the princes of Israel.'

21:5 'Jehoram was thirty and two years old when he began to reign, and he **reigned eight years** in Jerusalem.'

It goes on to tell of the demise of King Jehoram.

2 Chronicles 21:12 And there came a writing to him from Elijah the prophet, saying, Thus saith Yahweh Elohim of David thy father, Because thou hast not walked in the ways of Jehoshaphat thy father, nor in the ways of Asa king of Judah,

21:13 But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring,

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like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, which were better than thyself:

21:14 Behold, with a great plague will Yahweh smite thy people, and thy children, and thy wives, and all thy goods:

21:15 And thou shalt have great sickness by disease of thy bowels, until thy bowels fall out by reason of the sickness day by day.

21:16 Moreover Yahweh stirred up against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that were near the Ethiopians:

21:17 And they came up into Judah, and brake into it, and carried away all the substance that was found in the king's house, and his sons also, and his wives; so that there was never a son left him, save Jehoahaz, the youngest of his sons.

21:18 And after all this Yahweh smote him in his bowels with an incurable disease.

21:19 And it came to pass, that in process of time, after the end of two years, his bowels fell out by reason of his sickness: so he died of sore diseases. And his people made no burning for him, like the burning of his fathers.

21:20 Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings'.

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This letter from Elijah was not delivered to the King until the end of his sixth year of his reign. It is taught by some that this discrepancy is because these verses are not in Chronological order. An anomaly for the scriptures, to say this least, but it is a possibility. Albeit, not too sure of the plausibility.

But there is one verse that must be addressed. For it is sure to come up.

Hebrews 11:5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found because Elohim had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony that he pleased Elohim.

It is not definitely known who wrote Hebrews but Paul has been accredited with it. Some historians such as Tertullian suggest that Barnabas wrote it. Others suggest Apollos. The discrepancy is Hebrews does not have Paul's style of writing, in particular, the opening. Here is the issue. If Paul wrote 1 Corinthians 15:50 stating that flesh and blood cannot enter into the kingdom, then this would be a blatant contradiction of Hebrews 11:5. There can be only one answer. Paul did not write Hebrews.

Now we examine John 3:8

The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

So YAHSHUA is not merely being poetic. Spirit \approx wind \approx invisible moving force that manifests by effects. That isn't modern physics — but it is the correct philosophical form: an unseen causal field. John 3:8 describes a realm that is invisible, yet law-governed; unknowable by sight, yet undeniable by effect. That is the same epistemic structure as quantum reality — the unseen domain governing the seen. He was describing a REAL unseen domain, which modern physics has forced mankind to acknowledge as a valid category of reality.

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John 3:8 is one of the clearest statements in all of Scripture describing the invisible existence of the spiritual realm—and it does so in a way that parallels what modern physics calls quantum reality. YAHSHUA says, “The wind blows where it wishes... you hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it goes; so is everyone born of the Spirit.” The wind is not used as mere poetry. It is used as a physical demonstration of a higher truth: something can be real, active, and law-governed, while still being invisible and untraceable to ordinary human perception.

This is the very problem quantum physics forced upon the scientific world: the most fundamental level of reality cannot be “seen” directly—only its effects can be measured. We do not see the underlying state; we observe the outcomes. Likewise, the natural man cannot literally see the spiritual realm, yet the realm manifests through unmistakable results. The Spirit is not fantasy, symbolism, or imagination—it is an unseen domain producing visible evidence.

In John 3:8, YAHSHUA is declaring a profound reality: the unseen governs the seen, and those “born of the Spirit” have entered into that higher order of existence. There exists a higher-order identity capable of interaction with the unseen realm. The Realm inadvertently described by the discipline of Quantum Mechanics/Physics.

Now we get into what really happens when one is ‘Born Again’.

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John 3:9 Nicodemus answered and said unto him, How can these things be?

3:10 Yahshua answered and said unto him, Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things?

(The same can be said of today's Ministers, Pastors and Sheperds of the faithful. For they do not understand what you are about to read.)

John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

12:25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

There are only two ways to become 'Born Again'. The first involves leaving the physical body behind in order to enter into the spirit realm. That is, one must die. The saints that came out of their graves after the MESSIAH sacrificed HIMSELF, these were truly 'born again.' No one today or since the saints arose from the grave, has been, or is 'born again.'

Matthew 27:50 'Yahshua, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the spirit.

27:51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

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27:52 And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,

27:53 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.'

These were, and are for now, the only ones that have ever been born again. Born into the spirit realm. **No one alive today has been born again.** There is no such thing as a 'Born Again Christian'.

And in this, this Quantum realm, nothing exist as matter. Everything is in a form of energy. Only the state that it is in can be altered. Electrons, protons, photons etc... And such things as brain waves and conscious thought, both of which are energy. Science says that energy cannot be destroyed. And time is not a factor that has an effect on energy. Energy is eternal. As all things in the spirit/quantum realm.

The alternative way to enter into the spirit realm is to be transfigured.

1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

Commonly referred to as the 'Rapture'. (The word 'rapture' is not found in the Scriptures.)

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Transfiguration: the act or an instance of transfiguring or the state of being transfigured. Transfiguration is the unveiling of a higher nature already present—glory revealed, not a new identity created. New Testament; The change in the appearance of YAHSHUA that took place before three disciples.

Transformation = a change of nature or condition into something different from what it was before. It is an internal change, not just outward appearance. Transformation is an actual change of state—becoming something new, not merely appearing in a new form.

Matthew 17:2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

17:3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Eliyah talking with him.

These verses are an excellent precursory of what awaits those who choose to follow in the footsteps of the MESSIAH. A look at the final outcome of the event in the physical realm, changing 'in a twinkling of an eye' can be observed in Luke.

Luke 24:12 Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

HIS body was not to be found. It was gone. Transfigured into the spiritual/Quantum realm. This is the destiny of man. The next step in the 'evolution' of mankind for those who can accept it. When the human consciousness experience reaches a higher, loftier level and steps out of the physical realm of existence.

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This leaves just one issue to resolve. In Matthew'

Matthew 17:3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Eliyah talking with him.

There is a problem with this verse. Matthew 27:52&53 clearly states that the saints were still into the grave at the time when Moses and Elijah 'supposedly' appeared. This verse was an assumption on either Peter, James, John or Matthew that these two beings were Moses and Elijah.

Matthew 27:52 And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,

27:53 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

The most likely candidates would be the archangels, Michael and Gabriel.

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The 'Sonoran Oracle'
